Meaning: To give up (power, duties, obligations); to retire.

Example: The abdication of the Queen.

Abet

Meaning: To assist or encourage someone to do something illegal.

Example: She abetted the thief.

Abhor

Meaning: To strongly hate something.

Example: I abhor scammers.

Abnegation

Meaning: To deny or reject something (like a doctrine or belief); self-denial.

Example: Abnegation of political power.

Abscond

Meaning: To leave hurriedly and secretly; to run away.

Example: Prime suspect absconded to Mexico.

Abstruse

Meaning: Difficult to understand.

Example: Abstruse essay on quantum physics.

Abysmal

Meaning: Very bad or low in quality.

Example: The quality of his work is abysmal.

Accede

Meaning: To express approval; agree to do what you are asked.

Example: The government did not accede the requests of the citizens.

Accolade

Meaning: When someone is given an award or privilege to recognize their merit.

Example: My teacher received an accolade for his scientific work.

Accretion

Meaning: An addition to something.

Example: The house was expanded by the accretion of new outbuildings.

Accumulation

Meaning: A gathering or increase of something; growth by addition.

Example: Her goal for the coming year is to accumulate a large sum of money.

Acquaint

Meaning: To give someone information about something; to make familiar.

Example: We need to acquaint him with our goal.

Acrimonious

Meaning: Full of anger; bitter or harsh in manner or speech.

Example: Acrimonious debate about air pollution.

Act up

Meaning: To behave badly or oddly.

Example: The car's engine began to act up.

Acuity

Meaning: The ability to think, see, or hear very clearly.

Example: Visual acuity; political acuity.

Acumen

Meaning: The ability to make correct decisions or judgments.

Example: He has extraordinary financial acumen.

Adjacent

Meaning: Next to; nearby.

Example: Adjacent buildings; adjacent suburbs.

Adjure

Meaning: Order someone to do something.

Example: I adjure you to tell me the truth.

Adorn

Meaning: To make something more beautiful; to decorate.

Example: She loves to adorn the Christmas tree with her family.

Adroit

Meaning: Proficient; skillful.

Example: He became adroit in investing.

Adulterate

Meaning: To make something impure or weaker by adding something else.

Example: The beer had been adulterated with water.

Adumbrate

Meaning: To give the main points or summary of; to outline.

Example: The objectives of my dissertation were adumbrated on the first page.

Adversity

Meaning: An unfavorable turn of events; unlucky situation.

Example: He showed courage in the face of adversity.

Affable

Meaning: Friendly; easy to communicate.

Example: She was extremely affable on our first date.

Affectation

Meaning: Dishonest and insincere behavior or speech.

Example: Calling everyone 'sweetheart' is just an affectation.

Affluent

Meaning: Rich; wealthy; have a lot of money.

Example: Affluent nation; affluent people.

Afoot

Meaning: Being planned; in the process of development.

Example: Big changes are afoot at our city.

Agile

Meaning: Ability to move freely and quickly; ability to successfully and quickly deal with changes.

Example: He is such an agile climber.

Aggrandize

Meaning: To make greater or more powerful.

Example: The Queen sought to aggrandize her dynasty.

Ajar

Meaning: Slightly open.

Example: She had left the door ajar.

Alacrity

Meaning: Quickly; with enthusiasm; eagerly.

Example: He accepted my money with alacrity.

Albeit

Meaning: Even though; although.

Example: I tried, albeit without much success.

Amalgamate

Meaning: To unite; to bring together.

Example: Our firm has amalgamated with a British company.

Ambiguous

Meaning: Uncertain; having more than one possible meaning; doubtful.

Example: Her response to my proposal was somewhat ambiguous.

Amenable

Meaning: Easily persuaded; suggestible; manageable.

Example: Amenable children; amenable to argument.

Amend

Meaning: To make minor changes (mostly to the text) in order to improve or make better.

Example: Amend the constitution; amend the law; amend my way of living; amend the plan.

Amicable

Meaning: Friendly; peaceable; agreeable.

Example: Her behavior was amicable.

Anticipate

Meaning: To expect or predict that something will happen.

Example: We anticipate sales to pick up next week.

Aplomb

Meaning: Confident and relaxed, especially in difficult situations.

Example: He overcame difficulties with his usual aplomb.

Apocryphal

Meaning: Something that is most likely not true, but many people believe it to be true.

Example: Apocryphal stories; apocryphal sagas.

Appease

Meaning: Make peace with someone by giving them what they want.

Example: She tried to appease her little sister by giving her candies.

Apprise

Meaning: Inform someone about something.

Example: We will apprise you the results of your test.

Aquiver

Meaning: Trembling or shaking, mostly due to strong emotions.

Example: The breathtaking news set me aquiver.

Arbitrary

Meaning: Random; based on chance or personal preference.

Example: An arbitrary decision; an arbitrary choice.

Arcane

Meaning: Mysterious; secret.

Example: Arcane knowledge; arcane details of the agreement.

Archetype

Meaning: Typical or perfect example of something.

Example: Achilles is the archetype of the warrior.

Arduous

Meaning: Extremely difficult or hard; involves a lot of effort.

Example: Arduous work; arduous climb; arduous world tour.

Arid

Meaning: Dry (referring to the land or climate); uninteresting and boring.

Example: Sahara Desert is arid; his book is extremely arid.

Arouse

Meaning: To evoke or cause an emotion or particular feeling.

Example: Arouse a big laugh; arouse anger; arouse deep suspicion.

Artfully

Meaning: Demonstration of art, intelligence, or skill.

Example: Her shoes were artfully arranged in color hues.

Asinine

Meaning: Blunt; silly; stupid.

Example: Asinine remarks; asinine idea.

Assertion

Meaning: Claim that something is true; statement that you believe is true.

Example: His assertion is not supported by real evidence.

Assiduous

Meaning: Persistent; attentive to detail; caring.

Example: An assiduous student; assiduous in learning; assiduous research.

Assuage

Meaning: To make unpleasant feelings less painful or strong.

Example: A nurse can assuage someone's pain with medication.

Assume

Meaning: To accept or believe that something is true (without any proof).

Example: I assume everyone has a T-shirt.

Astounding

Meaning: Shocking; impressive; surprising.

Example: Astounding news; astounding result; astounding career.

Astute

Meaning: Able to see and react to various situations intelligently and quickly.

Example: Astute business decisions; astute investor.

Austere

Meaning: Extremely simple; plain.

Example: My father is a very austere man.

Avail

Meaning: To be of use; advantage; benefit.

Example: All our efforts did not avail.

Avarice

Meaning: Greedy desire for wealth and money.

Example: His avarice caused him to sell his father's house.

Avid

Meaning: Doing something as much as possible; very enthusiastic.

Example: He is an avid reader of short fantasy stories.

Axiomatic

Meaning: Unquestionable; obviously true.

Example: An axiomatic truth; axiomatic fact.

Banter

Meaning: Good-humored and friendly conversation.

Example: Two old friends bantered with each other.

Bashful

Meaning: Shy; easily embarrassed.

Example: He was too bashful to talk about his feelings.

Bash out

Meaning: To produce something quickly without much preparation.

Example: He bashed out about nine books a year.

Befuddle

Meaning: To confuse; make it impossible to think clearly.

Example: She was befuddled by a bottle of wine.

Beguide

Meaning: To charm or persuade someone, especially by saying nice words to them.

Example: He beguiled the voters with his big promises.

Belittle

Meaning: Make someone or something look unimportant.

Example: We should not belittle his achievements.

Belligerence

Meaning: Willingness to fight; aggressive and warlike behavior.

Example: She had a problem with her boyfriend's belligerence.

Benevolent

Meaning: Friendly; kind; helpful.

Example: Benevolent old man.

Bereft

Meaning: Lacking something.

Example: Bereft of inspiration; bereft of hope.

Bewilder

Meaning: Confusing; difficult to understand.

Example: She was bewildered by her son's reaction.

Blare

Meaning: Make loud and annoying sounds.

Example: Blare of broken speakers; blare of trumpets.

Boil up

Meaning: Experience a strong negative emotion.

Example: Anger was boiling up inside me.

Bombastic

Meaning: Trying to impress other people by saying things that sound impressive but don't mean much.

Example: The politician spoke in a bombastic manner.

Bone up

Meaning: Study hard; learn as much as possible about something.

Example: I need to bone up on my French grammar for a test on Monday.

Boon

Meaning: Helpful; beneficial; something that is asked.

Example: The rain was a boon to the withered crops.

Boondoggle

Meaning: Spend a lot of time and money, but achieve nothing; an unnecessary project.

Example: Our investments in oil were boondoggle.

Boorish

Meaning: Rude; bad-mannered; not caring about other people's feelings.

Example: Boorish behavior; boorish manner; he was very boorish.

Brackish

Meaning: Unpleasant; nasty; salty.

Example: Brackish water; brackish personality.

Brazen

Meaning: Done very openly and shockingly without shame; audacious.

Example: Brazen cheating; brazen lie; brazen love affairs.

Brooding

Meaning: Something that makes you feel uncomfortable or anxious, like something bad is about to happen.

Example: A brooding silence; brooding over what to do next.

Brusque

Meaning: Quick, unfriendly, and rough in manner or speech.

Example: The doctor spoke in a brusque tone.

Burgeon

Meaning: Develop; expand or grow rapidly.

Example: He burgeoned into a perfect doctor.

Bustling

Meaning: Noisy and full of activity.

Example: Bustling market; bustling streets.

Cajole

Meaning: Convince or persuade someone to do something by being kind to them or making false promises.

Example: She knows how to cajole people into doing what she wants.

Camaraderie

Meaning: Trust and friendship between people who spend a lot of time together; sociability; feeling of friendliness.

Example: I really like the camaraderie in our team.

Canny

Meaning: Smart and able to think quickly, especially in business.

Example: Canny investors; canny marketing; canny lawyer.

Cantankerous

Meaning: Bad-tempered; argue a lot.

Example: A cantankerous old man.

Cast aspersions

Meaning: Abusive attack on a person's reputation or good name.

Example: I want to cast aspersions on my political opponent.

Castigate

Meaning: To criticize someone; to speak angrily.

Example: John never missed an opportunity to castigate the rich.

Cavil

Meaning: Arguing or complaining about unimportant details.

Example: A customer caviled about new price.

Cessation

Meaning: Stopping or ending something.

Example: A cessation of Christmas sales.

Chide

Meaning: Talking angrily to someone because they did something stupid or bad.

Example: He chided her for bad manners.

Circumlocution

Meaning: Using more words than necessary instead of speaking directly; indirect way of speaking.

Example: A circumlocutory reply; diplomatic circumlocutions.

Circumspect

Meaning: Careful; unwilling to take risks.

Example: He is very circumspect in future actions.

Clandestine

Meaning: Planned or done secretly.

Example: Our group held yearly clandestine meetings.

Cliffhanger

Meaning: A very exciting ending to a part of a book or TV show.

Example: TV drama series ends on a cliffhanger.

Cloying

Meaning: Too sweet and therefore unpleasant.

Example: The film's cloying sentimentality.

Clumsy

Meaning: Not careful; without skill; awkward in movement.

Example: The first computers were hard and clumsy to use for casual consumers.

Clunky

Meaning: Solid; old-fashioned; large.

Example: A clunky gold ring.

Coercion

Meaning: Use force to convince someone to do something they don't want to do.

Example: The police used coercion.

Cogent

Meaning: Reasonable; persuasive; logical; strong; convincing.

Example: Cogent arguments; cogent evidence.

Coherent

Meaning: Logically connected; well planned.

Example: A coherent strategy; coherent plan.

Coincide

Meaning: Occur at the same time or in the same period; be the same or similar.

Example: I timed my vacation to coincide with my wife's; my ideas coincide with hers.

Commence

Meaning: To begin something; to start.

Example: They commence their new project.

Commensurate

Meaning: Equal in significance; corresponding in size.

Example: His salary must commensurate with his skills and experience.

Compunction

Meaning: A guilty feeling about doing something.

Example: She had lied to him without compunction.

Concede

Meaning: Unwillingly admit that something is true.

Example: She was forced to concede that he was right.

Conciliation

Meaning: The action of ending a disagreement.

Example: All attempts at conciliation failed and the debate continued.

Concomitant

Meaning: Something that happens with something else and is related, connected, or associated with it.

Example: Loss of memory is a concomitant of old age.

Condescending

Meaning: Treating someone as if you are more important, better, or smarter than them.

Example: The teacher is condescending towards the students.

Condolence

Meaning: Expression of sympathy when someone has recently died.

Example: David sent him a letter of condolence because of his brother's recent death.

Connive

Meaning: Secretly plan or try to achieve something; to allow something bad to happen.

Example: Some politicians connive at gambling.

Connotation

Meaning: The idea or feeling that a word evokes, beyond its literal meaning.

Example: For me, as a soldier, the word 'brotherhood' has a very positive connotation.

Construe

Meaning: To understand the meaning; make sense of.

Example: Different historians may construe the same historical event differently.

Contagious

Meaning: Spreads quickly; spread from one person to another.

Example: Fear is very contagious; this disease is highly contagious.

Contemplate

Meaning: Consider whether to do it or not.

Example: I'm contemplating going to France for a month.

Contravene

Meaning: Go against; to break the rule.

Example: His actions contravene the rules.

Conundrum

Meaning: Difficult problem or question.

Example: I have no answer to that conundrum.

Convergence

Meaning: When two separate elements join together or become similar.

Example: Converging roads; converging paths; converging opinions.

Convivial

Meaning: Pleasant; friendly; enjoyable.

Example: A convivial cocktail party.

Coruscant

Meaning: Sparkling; flashing; gleaming.

Example: Coruscant star; coruscant color.

Courteous

Meaning: Respectful; polite.

Example: Hotel staff must be courteous at all times.

Credulous

Meaning: Easily believe in something with little or no evidence.

Example: Credulous people always believe any TV advertisement.

Culpable

Meaning: Deserving blame; guilty; responsible for something bad.

Example: The judge found him culpable.

Curtail

Meaning: Reduce or limit something.

Example: You should try to curtail your expenses.

Debacle

Meaning: A powerful failure; fiasco.

Example: Her performance in the theater was a debacle.

Debase

Meaning: Reduce the value, status, or quality of something.

Example: Money has debased basketball.

Decimate

Meaning: To kill or destroy a large number of something.

Example: Decimate the population of exotic birds.

Deft

Meaning: Skillful; capable; clever; quick.

Example: The guitarist has deft fingers.

Delectable

Meaning: Delicious; attractive; tasteful.

Example: Delectable recipe; delectable meal; delectable lips.

Delineate

Meaning: Portray; accurately describe something; sketch out.

Example: Delineate the target; delineate characters; delineate the location.

Deluded

Meaning: To believe in something that is not real or true.

Example: We delude ourselves that we are in control.

Demure

Meaning: Shy; modest; bashful; quiet.

Example: He is always shy and demure with girls.

Denigrate

Meaning: To criticize someone hardly and unfairly; to spoil the reputation.

Example: Her terrible history denigrates her as a person.

Depute

Meaning: Transfer power to someone; allow someone to do something on your behalf.

Example: I have deputed my social media accounts to my manager.

Deride

Meaning: To criticize someone hardly, to laugh at someone.

Example: They deride her effort to get married as soon as possible.

Desecrate

Meaning: Deliberately damage something sacred, holy, or very much respected.

Example: The vandals desecrated the temple.

Deteriorate

Meaning: To become worse.

Example: Her health began to deteriorate.

Dexterous

Meaning: Very skillful and quick with their hands.

Example: Dexterous pianist; dexterous guitarist.

Digression

Meaning: Moving away from the main subject; turning aside.

Example: Digression from the main purpose of our meeting.

Discernment

Meaning: The ability to make good judgments.

Example: Anna shows good discernment in choosing friends.

Disclose

Meaning: To show what was hidden; to give out secret information to people.

Example: Disclose the details of a transaction; disclose your salary to colleagues.

Disconsolate

Meaning: Sad; unhappy; gloomy.

Example: Mary was disconsolate after her divorce.

Discrepancy

Meaning: The difference between two or more things that must be the same.

Example: A discrepancy between his public and private image.

Disdain

Meaning: Dislike someone or something; disrespect.

Example: Michael shows great disdain for the law.

Dislodge

Meaning: To remove something or someone from a position.

Example: Dislodge the rock; dislodge the Governor.

Disparage

Meaning: Express a negative opinion about someone or something.

Example: Don't disparage Mary's attempts to become a doctor.

Distraught

Meaning: Upset; sad; worried.

Example: My wife's death left me extremely distraught.

Docile

Meaning: Easily influenced or persuaded.

Example: Docile children; docile dogs.

Donnish

Meaning: Serious; smart; academic.

Example: He looks like a geek and donnish in manner.

Dour

Meaning: Antisocial; hard; unfriendly.

Example: He was a dour and gloomy man.

Dubious

Meaning: Not completely safe, true, or honest.

Example: Their claims were dubious and unproven.

Eagerly

Meaning: Enthusiastic about something; strong desire to have or do something.

Example: She's so eager to learn new language.

Ebullient

Meaning: Full of energy; positive.

Example: He was in ebullient mood.

Effete

Meaning: Weak; no longer capable; without power.

Example: Over the years, the king became effete.

Effrontery

Meaning: Bad behavior; extreme rudeness.

Example: He had the effrontery to ask for money after everything he had done to me.

Egalitarian

Meaning: Promotion of social equality and equal rights.

Example: Egalitarian society; this brand is not egalitarian.

Egregious

Meaning: Extremely bad.

Example: An egregious mistake; egregious behavior.

Eloquent

Meaning: Expressing what you mean using clear and efficient language.

Example: Eloquent speech; eloquent reminder.

Elucidate

Meaning: To clarify or explain something.

Example: Please elucidate this topic for me.

Embark

Meaning: To go onto a ship or to start doing something.

Example: He is about to embark on a lawyer career; embark on a boat trip.

Embellish

Meaning: To add details; to decorate.

Example: Please embellish your story with more details; I want to embellish my room with some flowers.

Embezzle

Meaning: To steal money.

Example: Anna was caught embezzling money from her parents.

Emboldened

Meaning: Give someone the courage to do something.

Example: I emboldened him to start a new business.

Empirical

Meaning: Based on observation or experience rather than theory.

Example: Empirical evidence; empirical studies; empirical analysis.

Enervating

Meaning: Tiring; exhausting.

Example: A hot climate enervates people.

Engulf

Meaning: To cover or surround something.

Example: The disease is threatening to engulf the entire country.

Enigma

Meaning: Mysterious or difficult to understand.

Example: She is an enigma to me.

Ennui

Meaning: Being tired or bored; having no interest in anything.

Example: I'm filled with sadness and ennui.

Ensnare

Meaning: To happen after or as a result of something.

Example: A brief silence ensued.

Entreat

Meaning: To try hard to convince someone to do something.

Example: I entreat you to stop lying to me.

Entrenched

Meaning: Fixed; exist for a very long time.

Example: Greed is entrenched in our society.

Eradicate

Meaning: To destroy something completely.

Example: These diseases are very difficult to eradicate.

Erroneous

Meaning: Wrong; incorrect.

Example: Erroneous conclusions; erroneous assumptions; erroneous opinion.

Eschew

Meaning: Deliberately avoiding something.

Example: I want my son to eschew bad company.

Evasive

Meaning: To avoid telling the truth by not directly answering a question.

Example: He gave an evasive answer to my question.

Exacerbation

Meaning: Make something bad even worse.

Example: Exacerbation of the disease.

Exaggeration

Meaning: Presenting something in an excessive manner.

Example: She tends to exaggerate all her difficulties in life.

Excogitate

Meaning: To plan something; think out.

Example: To excogitate a method.

Exemplify

Meaning: Be a typical example of something.

Example: This painting perfectly exemplifies the Renaissance style.

Explicit

Meaning: Clear and detailed.

Example: I gave him explicit instructions on how to complete the project.

Expunge

Meaning: Remove completely.

Example: She want to expunge the incident from her memory.

Extemporize

Meaning: To improvise; perform or speak without any preparation.

Example: The lead actor forgot his lines and had to extemporize.

Facetious

Meaning: Trying to be funny and flippant in a serious situation.

Example: John was so facetious that he turned everything into a joke.

Fallacious

Meaning: Not correct; based on incorrect reasoning.

Example: Fallacious arguments; fallacious opinion.

Fastidious

Meaning: Very attentive to details.

Example: Jack was fastidious in his preparation for Barbara's birthday.

Fatuous

Meaning: Silly; stupid; pointless.

Example: This TV commercial is very fatuous.

Feasible

Meaning: Possible; able to be done.

Example: It's not feasible to complete your request.

Feral

Meaning: Wild; savage; existing in the wild.

Example: Feral animals.

Fervent

Meaning: Shows strong feelings about something.

Example: Fervent football supporter; fervent patriots.

Festive

Meaning: Having the spirit of a holiday or festival.

Example: Festive mood; festive holiday atmosphere.

Fiendish

Meaning: Cruel; unpleasant; evil; terribly complex.

Example: Fiendish crimes; fiendish language; fiendish task.

Flabbergasted

Meaning: Extremely surprised or shocked.

Example: My husband was flabbergasted when I announced my pregnancy.

Flagrant

Meaning: Shockingly obvious and bad.

Example: Flagrant violations; flagrant waste of money.

Flare up

Meaning: Sudden onset or increase, escalation.

Example: When he is afraid, his asthma always flares up.

Flinch

Meaning: Make a sudden movement as a reaction to pain or fear.

Example: She didn't even flinch when the nurse gave the injection.

Fluctuate

Meaning: To change frequently.

Example: Meat prices fluctuated.

Flumoxed

Meaning: Unable to understand; extremely confused.

Example: Dr. John was flumoxed by my symptoms.

Forbearance

Meaning: Self-control; patience.

Example: You must treat your little kid with forbearance.

Forthcoming

Meaning: About to happen.

Example: The forthcoming season.

Frenzy

Meaning: Uncontrolled and wild behavior; madness.

Example: In a frenzy of jealousy, she killed him.

Fret

Meaning: Constant worry or anxiety.

Example: John fretted about the rent.

Furtive

Meaning: Tries to avoid attention; secret; hidden.

Example: She furtively called her lover.

Galvanize

Meaning: To get someone to act by affecting or shocking them.

Example: To galvanize the students into studying hard.

Gloat

Meaning: Feel or express great pleasure due to one's own success or someone else's failure.

Example: Her enemies gloated over her failure.

Gobble

Meaning: To eat something hungrily or quickly; quickly use a large amount of something.

Example: John gobbled his dinner.

Grandiloquent

Meaning: A way of using language in a very sophisticated way to get attention and admiration.

Example: A grandiloquent speaker; grandiloquent language.

Gregarious

Meaning: Sociable; likes to be with other people.

Example: Our kids are highly gregarious.

Grieve

Meaning: Feeling of great sadness.

Example: I need time to grieve after my wife's death.

Groggy

Meaning: Feeling tired, weak, or confused.

Example: This sleeping pill made me feel very groggy.

Hackneyed

Meaning: Overused; lack of originality.

Example: Hackneyed phrase; hackneyed slogans.

Haughty

Meaning: Unfriendly; think you are better or smarter than others.

Example: She always speaks to me in a haughty tone.

Hectic

Meaning: Full of activity; very busy.

Example: Hectic day; hectic schedule.

Homage

Meaning: Deep respect for someone or something.

Example: To pay homage to veterans.

Hunt out

Meaning: Search until you find something.

Example: I hunted out my first book to show Jenna.

Ignominious

Meaning: Shameful; embarrassing.

Example: Ignominious failure; ignominious defeat.

Illicit

Meaning: Forbidden by law or rules.

Example: Illicit guns; illicit drugs.

Immense

Meaning: Extremely large or great.

Example: Immense pressure; immense power; immense amount.

Impeccable

Meaning: Perfect; of highest standards.

Example: She has impeccable taste in clothes.

Impecunious

Meaning: Poor; having little or no money.

Example: He is from impecunious family.

Impertinent

Meaning: Rude and disrespectful.

Example: Impertinent question; impertinent remark.

Impetuous

Meaning: Sudden; impulsive; rush.

Example: She may regret her impetuous decision.

Implore

Meaning: Beg someone to do something.

Example: I implore you not to leave me.

Inadvertent

Meaning: Accidental; not intentional; unwanted.

Example: Inadvertent misplacement; inadvertent error.

Incensed

Meaning: Very angry.

Example: She was incensed by the rising cost of education.

Incessant

Meaning: Continues without stopping.

Example: Incessant snowfall; incessant rain.

Inchoate

Meaning: Not yet properly developed; just started; partly formed.

Example: Inchoate plan; inchoate cancer.

Inconsequential

Meaning: Not important; trivial.

Example: Her work seems inconsequential.

Incumbent

Meaning: To have a certain official position.

Example: Incumbent President faces a tough fight for re-election next year.

Indelible

Meaning: Not able to be removed, forgotten, or erased.

Example: Indelible ink stain; indelible impression.

Indispensable

Meaning: Absolutely necessary.

Example: Smartphone is indispensable in modern life.

Indolent

Meaning: Lazy; wanting to avoid activity; slow; showing no interest.

Example: She is as indolent as her cat; indolent tumors; indolent reply.

Indubitable

Meaning: Something that can't be doubted; unquestionable.

Example: An indubitable truth; indubitable fact.

Inept

Meaning: Not skilled; not qualified; ineffective.

Example: He was an inept worker.

Inexorable

Meaning: Impossible to stop.

Example: Inexorable technological progress.

Inexplicable

Meaning: Impossible to explain.

Example: Her actions are completely inexplicable.

Inevitable

Meaning: Impossible to avoid or prevent.

Example: Their conflict was inevitable.

Infatuation

Meaning: A strong and short-living feeling of love.

Example: Her infatuation with him lasted one month.

Inimical

Meaning: Unfriendly; harmful; hostile; stop something from progressing.

Example: Government actions are inimical to economic growth.

Innate

Meaning: Something you were born with, natural.

Example: Innate sense of humor; innate talent.

Insatiable

Meaning: Impossible to satisfy.

Example: I have an insatiable lust for power.

Inscrutable

Meaning: Impossible to understand or interpret.

Example: An inscrutable face; inscrutable smile.

Insouciant

Meaning: Not worrying about possible problems; relaxed and happy; free from concern; carefree.

Example: He leads an insouciant life.

Interminable

Meaning: Seemingly endless.

Example: I'm tired of this interminable discussion; interminable stories of his baseball career.

Intransigent

Meaning: Refusal to compromise.

Example: Our company is intransigent and rejects all my ideas about innovation.

Intrepid

Meaning: Extremely brave; fearless.

Example: A squad of intrepid soldiers.

Intrinsic

Meaning: Essential; significant; extremely important.

Example: English language is an intrinsic part of the school curriculum.

Inveterate

Meaning: Habitual; one who does something extremely often.

Example: Inveterate gambler; inveterate smoker.

Invigorate

Meaning: To make someone feel fresh and full of energy.

Example: She was invigorated by the morning shower.

Irrevocable

Meaning: Impossible to change; final.

Example: Her decision is irrevocable.

Jaded

Meaning: Bored; tired; not happy.

Example: I felt extremely jaded after working all day.

Jarring

Meaning: Unexpected; unpleasant; shocking.

Example: Jarring sound; jarring note in her voice.

Jejune

Meaning: Very simple; dull; naive.

Example: Jejune behavior; jejune generalizations; jejune remark.

Jibe

Meaning: Rude and aggressive remark.

Example: He jibed constantly at the way she ran her company.

Jocular

Meaning: Humorous; playful.

Example: Jocular mood; jocular personality; jocular tone.

Jubilation

Meaning: A feeling of great happiness and triumph.

Example: The news about victory was greeted with jubilation.

Kitschy

Meaning: To be tasteless; ugly; without style.

Example: Kitschy culture; kitschy decorations.

Lash out

Meaning: Suddenly become aggressive or attack someone.

Example: He lashed out and knocked out my teeth.

Laudable

Meaning: Deserves praise or admiration.

Example: A laudable performance; laudable effort.

Lingers

Meaning: Takes a long time to disappear or die; gradually disappearing or dying.

Example: The smell of your perfume always lingers on my shirt.

Loquacious

Meaning: The one who talks a lot.

Example: Loquacious comedian.

Lousy

Meaning: Poor; of a very bad quality; disgusting.

Example: I'm lousy at baseball; the food was lousy.

Lucrative

Meaning: Profitable; making a lot of money.

Example: My business is very lucrative.

Ludicrous

Meaning: Stupid; foolish; unreasonable.

Example: Ludicrous idea; ludicrous joke.

Lushy (Slang word in American English)

Meaning: Drunk; beery; alcoholic.

Maddening

Meaning: Makes you feel angry; extremely annoying.

Example: Maddening habit; maddeningly slow.

Magic away

Meaning: Make something disappear.

Example: I wish I could magic us away from this boring lesson.

Mediocre

Meaning: Of average quality.

Example: Her new book was pretty mediocre.

Mendacious

Meaning: Lying; not telling the truth.

Example: These statements are mendacious; her arguments are mendacious.

Mercurial

Meaning: Changes suddenly or unpredictably.

Example: A mercurial temperament.

Misdemeanor

Meaning: Not so serious crime; a minor wrongdoing.

Example: The player was disqualified for a drug misdemeanor.

Modicum

Meaning: A small amount of something.

Example: He is a bad doctor without a modicum of medical knowledge.

Morbid

Meaning: Unhealthy interest in unpleasant topics, such as death or illness.

Example: Dan has a morbid fascination with blood.

Mundane

Meaning: Ordinary; commonplace; not interesting.

Example: Her job is very mundane.

Munificent

Meaning: Very generous.

Example: He donated a munificent amount of money to charity.

Myriad

Meaning: Extremely great amount of something.

Example: Myriad of problems; myriad of options.

Negligent

Meaning: Unable to properly take care of anything; careless.

Example: Dr. Bob was negligent in her duties.

Nibble

Meaning: Take small bites out.

Example: She nibbled a croissant.

Nimble

Meaning: Fast and light in motion.

Example: Nimble fingers; nimble tongue.

Nonchalant

Meaning: Calm and relaxed.

Example: John is completely nonchalant about his future.

Obliterate

Meaning: Completely destroy something.

Example: Dan tried to obliterate the memory of the accident.

Obloquy

Meaning: Strong public criticism.

Example: The president's admission of adultery caused an obloquy among voters.

Obsequious

Meaning: Too eager to help or agree with someone.

Example: Mike is obsequious to all those in power.

Obsolete

Meaning: Outdated; no longer used.

Example: His work is now obsolete because of the machines.

Obstreperous

Meaning: Noisy; aggressive; difficult to control.

Example: An obstreperous child.

Ominous

Meaning: To assume that something bad might happen.

Example: Ominous dark clouds; ominous silence.

Opulent

Meaning: Wealthy; rich; luxurious.

Example: Opulent lifestyle; opulent house.

Ostensible

Meaning: Seems true, but not necessarily.

Example: Ostensible reason; ostensible ownership; ostensible purpose.

Outrageous

Meaning: Extremely bad; morally unacceptable.

Example: I must apologize for my outrageous behavior.

Overt

Meaning: Open; not hidden.

Example: An overt act of aggression; overt criticism.

Pal around

Meaning: Spend time with someone as a friend.

Example: I used to pal around with her in college.

Parsimonious

Meaning: Not willing to spend money.

Example: He is too parsimonious to buy a second laptop for work.

Paucity

Meaning: Small amount; not enough of something.

Example: There's a paucity of skilled workers.

Penitent

Meaning: Show that you are sorry for something bad that you did.

Example: He is deeply penitent.

Peremptory

Meaning: Expect other people to accept something immediately and without question; not open to appeal.

Example: Peremptory instructions; peremptory in tone; peremptory commands.

Perfidious

Meaning: Unfaithful; unable to be trusted.

Example: Our company was betrayed by perfidious employees.

Perfunctory

Meaning: Done without much care, attention, or interest.

Example: The police made a perfunctory search of the house.

Perky

Meaning: Happy and cheerful.

Example: Their child is so perky.

Pernicious

Meaning: Dangerous; harmful.

Example: Cigarettes are pernicious to the health.

Perpetual

Meaning: Lasts forever; never ending.

Example: Perpetual constitution; perpetual license.

Pertain to

Meaning: Connected with; related to; refer to.

Example: Her remark did not pertain to the topic.

Pompous

Meaning: Someone who thinks he is too important or serious.

Example: Pompous rhetoric; pompous politician.

Precise

Meaning: Exact; accurate.

Example: Precise date; precise information.

Promulgate

Meaning: To spread; make something widely known.

Example: Promulgate the belief; promulgate information.

Propitious

Meaning: Shows a good chance of success.

Example: It was a propitious time to launch their new game.

Protracted

Meaning: Lasting for a long time.

Example: Protracted dispute; protracted negotiations.

Puerile

Meaning: Childish; silly.

Example: She has a puerile sense of humor.

Pugnacious

Meaning: Ready to argue or fight; aggressive.

Example: Mike gets very pugnacious when he drinks.

Querulous

Meaning: Annoying; often complaining.

Example: He complained in a querulous voice; querulous old man.

Quirky

Meaning: Unique in an interesting way.

Example: His sense of humor was quite quirky.

Quixotic

Meaning: Super-idealistic and unrealistic.

Example: His plan to become the richest man on the planet was quixotic.

Rancorous

Meaning: Hateful; angry.

Example: Rancorous dispute; rancorous attack.

Ravage

Meaning: To damage or ruin something.

Example: Our house was ravaged by the flood.

Ravishing

Meaning: Extremely beautiful and attractive.

Example: She looked so ravishing in that dress.

Recalcitrant

Meaning: Unwilling to obey orders.

Example: Recalcitrant children; recalcitrant workers.

Recluse

Meaning: Living alone; avoiding the company of other people.

Example: Many creative people are recluses.

Recondite

Meaning: Difficult or impossible to understand.

Example: This article is full of recondite information.

Reluctant

Meaning: Unwilling to do something.

Example: He was reluctant to work.

Replete

Meaning: Extremely full.

Example: She was replete with food.

Repudiate

Meaning: Claim that something is not true; refuse to accept.

Example: Repudiate evidence; repudiate a contract.

Resplendent

Meaning: Bright; attractive; impressive.

Example: She was resplendent in that skirt.

Reticent

Meaning: Someone who doesn't want to talk about their feelings.

Example: She is very reticent about her past.

Revitalize

Meaning: To give something new life.

Example: Revitalize our society; revitalize your energy.

Rubicon

Meaning: Point of no return.

Example: Today I crossed the Rubicon and now there is no going back.

Sagacious

Meaning: Smart and able to make the right decisions.

Example: Sagacious businessman; sagacious old man.

Sanguine

Meaning: Cheerful; optimistic; confident.

Example: He is sanguine about his future.

Scintillating

Meaning: Brilliantly clever; shining; skillful.

Example: Scintillating mind; scintillating jewelers.

Scruffy

Meaning: Messy; dirty.

Example: Scruffy T-shirt.

Searing

Meaning: Very hot or intense.

Example: Searing heat; searing pain.

Shenanigans

Meaning: Secret or dishonest activities.

Example: Business shenanigans.

Shrewd

Meaning: Able to judge people and situations clearly.

Example: John is a shrewd businessman.

Simmer down

Meaning: Become peaceful or less angry.

Example: Simmer down and stop hitting him!

Sluggish

Meaning: Slow-moving; not energetic; inactive.

Example: Heavy breakfast makes me sluggish.

Soothing

Meaning: Making you feel calm and relaxed.

Example: Soothing voice; soothing music.

Sordid

Meaning: Dirty; dishonest; nasty.

Example: Sordid business; sordid affairs.

Squeamish

Meaning: Easily made to feel sick or disgusted.

Example: I'm terribly squeamish about blood.

Squander

Meaning: To waste money in a foolish manner.

Example: Don't squander your money on an unnecessary fifth car.

Surreptitiously

Meaning: Done secretly; by stealth.

Example: Mike surreptitiously passed him exam answers.

Tatty

Meaning: In a bad condition; old.

Example: Tatty old jacket.

Tentative

Meaning: Not certain; not fixed.

Example: Tentative conclusions; tentative report.

Tenuous

Meaning: Very weak; unsure.

Example: Tenuous connection; tenuous evidence.

Timid

Meaning: Shy; without much confidence.

Example: Every time John sees Mary, he acts like a timid child.

Titivate

Meaning: To make more attractive.

Example: Titivate her costume with some accessories.

Treacherous

Meaning: Most likely to betray; very dangerous; difficult to deal with.

Example: Your ex best friend's treacherous intentions to reveal all your secrets; treacherous weather; treacherous road; treacherous path; treacherous hike.

Trespass

Meaning: Break into someone's property without permission.

Example: He was trespassing on private property.

Turmoil

Meaning: A state of intense anxiety, confusion, or uncertainty.

Example: After the crisis, the country was in turmoil.

Turpitude

Meaning: Wickedness; amoral behavior.

Example: Moral turpitude.

Ubiquitous

Meaning: Seems to be everywhere.

Example: A ubiquitous fashion.

Ulterior

Meaning: Intentionally hidden; secret.

Example: Ulterior purpose; ulterior motives.

Unparagoned

Meaning: Having no analogues; incomparable.

Example: Unparagoned recipe; unparagoned sense of style.

Unhinge

Meaning: To make someone mentally unstable.

Example: The stress completely unhinged her.

Vacillate

Meaning: To waver between two options or opinions.

Example: This time, she did not vacillate and accepted the offer.

Valiant

Meaning: Showing courage or determination.

Example: Valiant knight; valiant effort.

Venal

Meaning: Corrupt; prone to bribery.

Example: Venal policeman; venal judge.

Verbose

Meaning: Containing more words than necessary.

Example: Verbose explanation; verbose report.

Vigilant

Meaning: Careful and watchful, especially to avoid danger.

Example: He tried to be vigilant and report anything suspicious.

Virulent

Meaning: Dangerous; harmful in its effects.

Example: Virulent infection; virulent disease; virulent media campaign against him.

Vociferous

Meaning: Speaks loudly and with great energy.

Example: He was a vociferous speaker.

Voracious

Meaning: Want a lot of something.

Example: He was a voracious stamp-collector.

Wreathe

Meaning: To cover, encircle, or surround something.

Example: The clouds wreathed the hills; she was wreathed in smoke.
