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About the course

English for Everyone Junior: Beginner's Practice Book is a companion to the English for Everyone Junior: Beginner's Course. The course book is divided into 26 units - each with its own theme - and the practice book mirrors that structure. There is audio for all the units.



Our characters

A group of six friends - Maria, Sofia, Ben, Andy, Sara, and Max - help you practise language in a natural and friendly way.

Unit structure

Each practice unit starts with a scene that presents the vocabulary taught in the corresponding course book unit. The child then practises this vocabulary along with the grammar rules they learned in that unit of the course book.



New vocabulary

The illustrated scene helps the child practise the vocabulary, as they listen to each word and write it in the correct space.







Vocabulary practice

There is more vocabulary practice. The child might be asked to match vocabulary to pictures or spell individual words. while also revising vocabulary.

Grammar practice

Each unit then practises the grammar rules taught in the corresponding course book unit

4 Grammar practice

More grammar is practised. Many units also have a song to help learn new grammar and vocabulary.

Audio

English for Everyone Junior: Beginner's Practice Book features extensive supporting audio resources. Listening to and repeating the audio recordings will help the child to master the pronunciation and stress patterns of English, as well as help them to fix new language in their memory.

All vocabulary scenes, songs, and listening exercises have accompanying audio.
Clicking on the corresponding number on the app will play the relevant audio file.



Most exercises have accompanying audio. After completing an exercise, the child should listen to the correct answers and then repeat them out loud.







Review units

Four review units provide the child with a chance to read a text incorporating vocabulary and grammar from recent units. The child then writes a personalized answer based on this text.



Handwriting guide

The book includes a guide explaining how to form each letter of the English alphabet. The child has space to practise the formation of each letter.



Answers

At the back of the book, answers to all the exercises are clearly presented. Key information is sometimes shown in bold to make it easier to mark the child's work.

Practising new vocabulary

Each unit opens with an illustrated scene that matches the course book, but with the words removed and placed in a panel. The parent or teacher should supervise the child as they listen to the accompanying audio on the website or the app and write the correct words in the spaces.

1 First, click on the corresponding unit number (here **Unit 15**) on your screen. Then, click on the exercise number and play each audio file in turn.

All the words needed to 2 complete the scene are given in a word pool.




- 3 After listening to each word, the child should write it down in the correct space, using the panel to help them.
- 4 After completing the scene by writing in all the words, press Play all to listen to all the words again.
- 5 The audio pauses for a few seconds after each word. The child should repeat the word during this pause.

Practising new grammar

Grammar is practised in the same order that it is taught in the corresponding course book unit. Throughout the grammar exercises, vocabulary from the unit is repeated and recycled to help the child memorize it and see it used in context.


- The child practises the grammar from the corresponding course book unit in exercises that reuse the unit's vocabulary.




- Most exercises have an audio recording so the child can listen to the questions and correct answers after completing each exercise.
