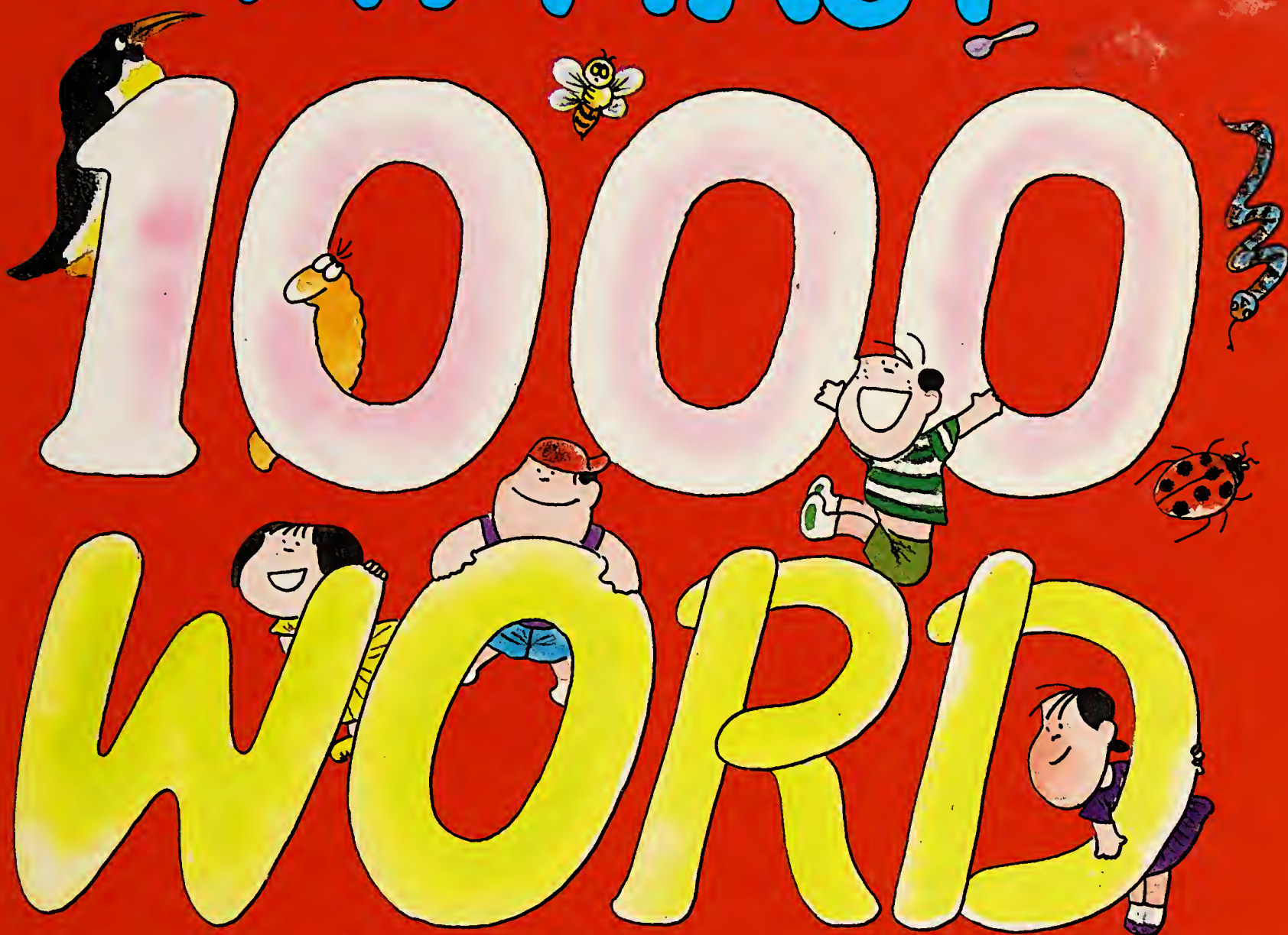

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PREFACE

MY FIRST 1000 WORD DICTIONARY has been compiled with the aim of making learning both stimulating and fun for children. This is important for children of elementary school age in whom an eagerness to learn and discover can be so readily instilled.

All the entries are based on wordlists of major textbooks used in the elementary schools. Meanings of all the entries are shown in ordinary sentence form with illustrations in full-color for further clarification.

The entry is printed in bold type. Where there are different meanings for one word, these will be shown in separate sentences. Additional useful information is given alongside certain types of entries:

- the past simple tense and present participle under the verb entries
e.g. **arrange** arranged, arranging
- the plurals of noun entries with irregular forms
e.g. **wolf** wolves
- the other pronoun forms under the subject pronoun entries
e.g. **he** him, his

Certain words have been grouped together under one entry

- e.g. **building** : school, house, shops, cinema, fire station,
factory
- machine** : vacuum cleaner, iron, typewriter, computer,
bulldozer, toaster, sewing machine
- shape** : circle, rectangle, square, triangle, cone
- tree** : pine, willow, mango, palm

- Holidays

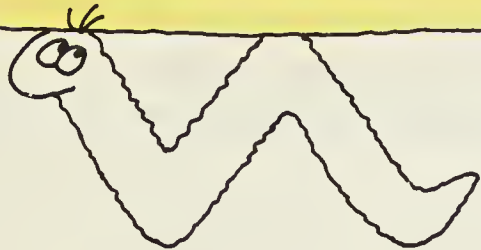
The supplements are designed to enable children to learn a word in the context of the group it is associated with.
