

# **Spelling Strategies**

Learning a few simple strategies can help students become better spellers. Teach the strategies one at a time using appropriate words from the spelling lists. List each strategy on a chart as it is introduced. Post the chart as a helpful reminder to students. Review the strategies frequently to help students internalize them.

Say a word correctly.	Don't leave out or mispronounce sounds. Write the sounds in the correct order.
Think about what the word looks like.	Think about how the spelling pattern looks.Write it, look at it, decide if it looks correct.
Look for small words in spelling words.	spin - pin, in cupcake - cup, cake
Look at syllables in spelling words.	Spell the word one syllable at a time. remember - re•mem•ber
Use rhyming words to help spell a word.	lf you can spell book, you can spell look.
Use rules for adding endings.	Drop silent e before adding suffix. Double the final consonant before adding suffix. Change the final y to i and add es.
Use knowledge of suffixes and prefixes.	Think about what the word looks like without the prefix or suffix. Write the word and then add the prefix or suffix.
Think about what the word means.	Some words sound the same, but have different meanings and are spelled in different ways. Match the spelling with its meaning.
Use outside help.	Use words posted around the classroom. Use a dictionary. Ask someone for help.
