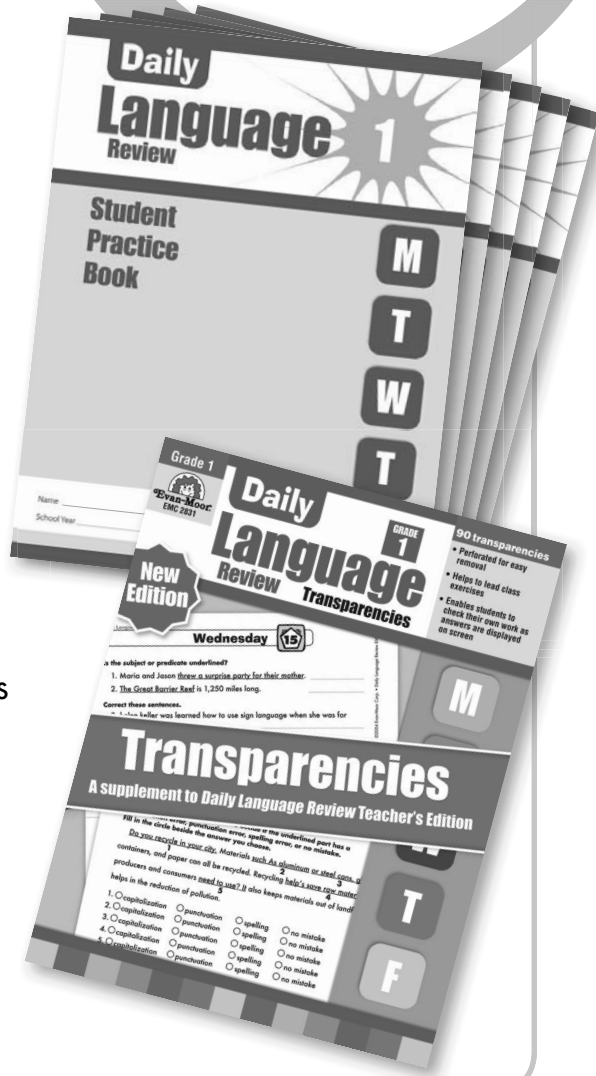

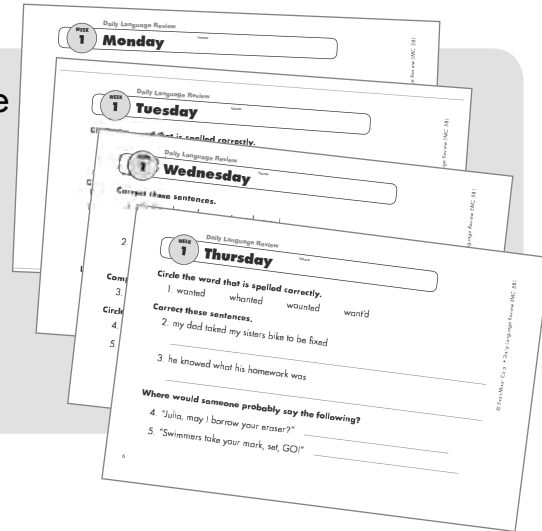

This book is divided into 36 weekly sections. Each weekly unit provides daily assessment activities.

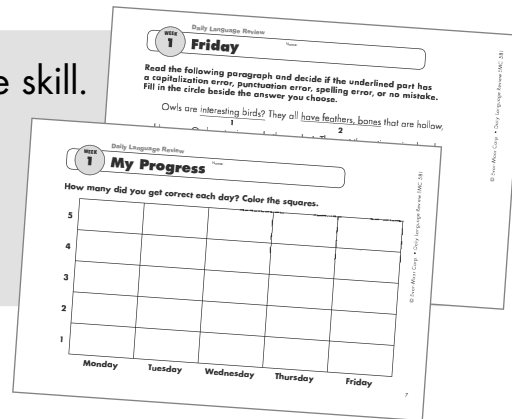
Monday through Thursday
