









Classifying: On the Go

The learning skills that follow can help your child become a better reader. By focusing on these skills, your child will comprehend more of what he or she reads. As your child's technical reading skills continue to develop, so will his or her ability to comprehend and enjoy the material.

Classifying

Classifying involves dividing objects or words into groups based on their similarities. Help your child understand that there are different ways to separate things. For example, a bucket of blocks could be divided by color, by shape, or by material.

Take turns organizing groups of toys with your child. Include one item in each group that doesn't belong. Ask your child to find that item and explain why it doesn't belong. You can try a similar activity with food in your cupboards, including boxed and canned items.

Cut out pictures from a magazine, and have your child classify them in various ways. Try to include items of a single color, as well as pictures of animals, toys, and children.

Classifying is an activity that can take place anywhere. Pick up a leaf on a walk, or point to a stop sign. Ask your child what else he or she could put in a group with these items. Then, extend the activity by asking him or her to think of something that would not belong in those groups.

Comprehension

Comprehension is an important part of your child's skills as an early reader. Children who are learning to read often focus intently on individual letters and words. By asking your child questions about what he or she has read, you will remind your child to focus on the meanings of the words as well.

After your child reads a story or watches a movie, help him or her compose a letter or e-mail about it. Your child can relate the plot and choose favorite parts to share with a friend or relative. Allow your child to write as much of the message as he or she is able. You can also have your child dictate the letter to you.

After reading a favorite story, invite your child to imagine what happens next. Provide prompts if necessary. Write your child's addition to the story on paper, or type it on a computer and print it out. Leave space for him or her to include illustrations.

Following directions is an important element in schoolwork, as well as in life outside of school. Help your child develop this skill during everyday activities.

Try cooking something simple, such as pancakes, with your child. Read each step of the recipe aloud. Let your child participate in as many steps of the process as possible. Remind him or her that the food you make is a success because you followed the directions together.

Do a scavenger hunt in the house or yard with your child. Hide small toys, and take turns giving each other directions to find them.

Draw a simple map that shows the route from your home to your child's school, the library, or the grocery store. Include familiar landmarks, such as a friend's house, a large tree, or a park. Ask your child to use the map to give you directions from one place to another.

Choose an activity that is very familiar to your child. It might be setting the table for dinner or getting ready for bed. Ask your child to give you directions that explain each step of the process.

Same and Different

This skill involves focusing your child's attention on the ways that things are alike and not alike. When you and your child are discussing the ways that items are the same and different, encourage him or her to use specific descriptive terms (including color, shape, size, position, and pattern.)

When your child gets dressed in the morning, ask him or her how your outfit (or a sibling's) is the same or different.

Ask your child to walk around the room and search for pairs of things that are the same in some way, such as the same color or same size.

<u>Sequencing</u>

Sequencing is a skill that involves putting things in order. Your child can look for sequences in his or her daily activities, as well as in activities that include a series of steps.

Find photos of your child at various ages. Ask your child to put them in order. Then, have him or her explain what details were helpful in determining the order.

Sit down with your child, and ask him or her to think of three things that happened that day. Ask your child to draw a picture of each and label the pictures with the words first, next, and last.

After you read a book or watch a movie with your child, ask him or her to tell you the main points of the story in sequence. Encourage your child to use order words, such as first, then, after, next, and last.
